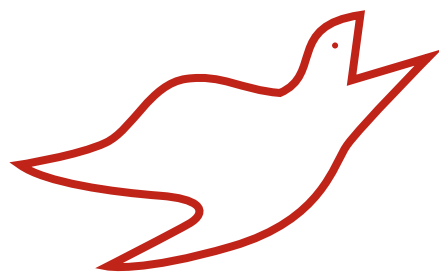

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I. IDLTP

On 8 December 2017, the International Day of Living Together in Peace (IDLTP) was adopted unanimously by the 193 Member States of the United Nations General Assembly - resolution A/RES/72/ 130, article 4 of which *"calls on all Member States to continue to work towards reconciliation to contribute to peace and sustainable development, including by working with communities, religious leaders and other stakeholders, taking measures of reconciliation and solidarity and encouraging human beings to forgiveness and compassion"*.

It is a means of regularly mobilizing the efforts of the international community in favor of peace, tolerance, inclusion, understanding, and solidarity, and an opportunity for all people to express the deep desire to live and to act together, united in difference and diversity, to build a viable world based on peace, solidarity, and harmony.

Since then, the IDLTP has been celebrated worldwide every 16 May, thanks to the participation of cities, which play a leading role in promoting the objectives.

Acting for the promotion of Education for the Culture of Peace means:

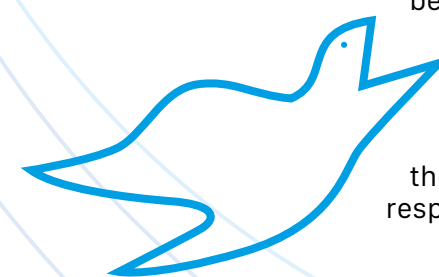
- Build the world of tomorrow, a world of peace, with each other and not against each other.

Each day spent in indifference and inaction leaves young and future generations a humanity that is more threatened by the intensity of growing challenges: climate change, continual wars, loss of fundamental freedoms, deterioration in the standard and quality of life, harmful use of artificial intelligence, social fracture, hate speech, rejection of others, discrimination of all kinds, migratory flows, indigence, and poverty, among other things.

At the heart of these multiple challenges are suffering human lives in a world that is becoming more fragmented and dehumanized daily. We are still today witnesses to a dramatic conflict that originated in the heart of Europe, which degenerates a little more every day and which could lead us to a global explosion where we would all be losers.

Yet another outcome is still possible if a new path, Education for a Culture of Peace, sees the light of day and brings together all the people of goodwill to act together and find a remedy for the evils that undermine our humanity.

VI. WHO ARE WE?

VISION AND VALUES

The International Sufi Alâwiyya Association (AISA), constituted as a non-governmental non-profit association, was created on October 11, 2001, as an association under the 1901 law. With special consultative status with the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations, its main vocation is to contribute to the emergence of a society of better living together by promoting the Culture of Peace in the world.

Under the honorary presidency of Sheikh Khaled Bentounes¹, it is based on an international network of multidisciplinary skills and people convinced that the unity of humanity is, through and in its diversity, an inexhaustible source of enrichment for a humanism without ceases to be renewed and that new paths for a culture of peace can be born, grow and revitalize what humanity has best within it.

AISA International NGO pursues its missions in complete independence, drawing its values from the universal wisdom of the Alâwî Sufi order, recognized by UNESCO as a "school for tolerance and interreligious conviviality" (191 EX/32, 17 April 2013, p.3).

Each year, it publishes its activity report. Its resources come mainly from membership fees and private donations.

"The 'Alâwî Sufî order, founded by Sheikh al-'Alâwî, makes the promotion of interreligious dialogue its priority. The Order shows how best to serve humanity; how to try to harmonize and beautify the world. It accepts and admits everything that can bring material comfort to man but always in close relation with the inner dimension, in a permanent balance between the profane and the sacred. The order relies on the loving brotherhood of men. It invites, in fact, not to reject rationality to the detriment of spirituality, not to lock oneself in a fearful religiosity."
